666 and the Roman Papal Church.

In the book of Revelation, we read:

- Here is wisdom. Let him who has understanding calculate the number of the beast, for the number is that of a man, and his number is six hundred and sixty-six!" (Rev. 13:18).

The alphabet of all letters in the Latin, Greek and Hebrew language have numerical values. To know the numerical value of a word, all a person needs to do, is add up the numbers of the letters of the word. There are many ways this method shows that the number 666 refers to the Roman Catholic Church. The numerical value of the word Lateinos, meaning Latin, is 666.
