### THE SEVEN ABOMINATIONS THE LORD HATES

---

- **Proverbs 6:16–18:** There are six things that the LORD hates, seven that are an abomination to him: <sup>17</sup> haughty eyes, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood, <sup>18</sup> a heart that devises wicked plans, feet that make haste to run to evil, <sup>19</sup> a false witness who breathes out lies, and one who sows discord among brothers.

**Abomination:** comes from the Hebrew word (*tow`ebah*) and means to loathe, utterly detest, and have a strong and intense disapproval of something (especially idolatry or an idol).

**Haughty:** come from the Hebrew word (*ruwm*) and means to highly esteem and exalt oneself above others.

#### The seven abominations:

1. Haughty eyes, (embraces a proud look, and those who see themselves as superior, and exalt themselves above others.
2. A lying tongue, (embraces those who deceive, mislead, swindle, con, cheat and two-time).
3. Hands that shed innocent blood, (embraces those who murder, abuse others, and inflict violence upon the innocent).
4. A heart that devises wicked imaginations, (embraces those who devise evil and malicious plans that bring harm to others, physically, financially, sexually, emotionally, and spiritually).
5. Feet that are swift in running to mischief, (embraces those who are full of malice, and take pleasure in causing trouble and in doing wrong).
6. A false witness who breathes out lies, (embrace those who are untruthful, dishonest, deceitful, and speak deceptively against the accused when witnessing).
7. One who sows discord among brothers and sisters in Christ, (embraces those who cause conflict, strife, and division).

### FURTHER OFFENSES GOD CONSIDERS TO BE AN ABOMINATION

---

The following list contains other behaviours and practices that are abominations before the LORD:

- Indulging in abominable vices to gratify the lusts.
- Favouring the antichrist beast system.

- Adultery and speaking blasphemous words against God.
- Covetousness, cruelty, deceitfulness, and drunkenness.
- Envy and evil desires.
- Faithlessness, false preachers, and fornicators.
- Greediness and spreading gossip.
- Heartless, and hostility toward God and the Lord Jesus Christ and toward those who belong to His Kingdom.
- Hypocrisy, liars, kidnappers, and worship of idols.
- Maliciousness, ruthlessness, murders, abusers, rapist, and violence.
- Proud religious ministers who proclaim God's word for their own gain.
- Oppressors of the poor, and using people for one's own selfish gain.
- Revilers who speak abusively and contemptuously of another, and abusively and angrily scold and berate others.
- Atheists who deliberately and consciously chose to deny God.
- Indulging in sexually immoral practices, orgies, and child abuse.
- Sorcerers, swindlers, spiteful behaviour, and those who cause strife.
- Thieves, vandalism, and are unrighteous.
- Violence, brutality, and wars, especially those fought to increase one's own power and gain. (Rom. 1:29, 31) (1 Cor. 6:9-10) (Gal 5:19, 21) (Ephes. 5:5) (Philip. 3:19) (Col. 3:5) (Rev. 21:8).

All of these are an abomination before God, and those who practise them will not enter the Holy City, for their end is destruction. These all stand in contrast to those who are admitted into the Holy City, yet amongst those who are permitted to enter, not one is free of sin, and there are those who have through fear, temptations, faithlessness, worldliness, and fleshliness sinned. It is true, sin exclude entry into the Holy City, but it is sin that is loved and unrepented of, that closes the gate of the city, that remains open day and night to all who repent before God, and by faith trust in the Lord Jesus Christ to be saved, and who endeavour to live a lifestyle that honours God and brings a good name to the Lord Jesus Christ, and the Christian faith.

Every sincere believer, however weak, should be encouraged, by the words, "I will give from the spring of the water of life without payment," and every obstinate sinner should be terrified, and, if possible, awakened, that in the day of the final judgment, neither the righteous or the unrighteous will have grounds to complain that they have not been with plainness of speech, and their own conscience warned and cautioned.

**SNAPSHOT:** It is interesting, to notice when Christians use the word abomination, in most cases it is only used concerning those in same sex relationships, I have never yet heard, a prideful man of God been called an abomination, or those who cause division amongst the brethren, which highlights the reality (generally speaking) Christians consciously or unconsciously consider same sex relationships at the top of the tree of sin, whereas the seven abominations listed above, and the following list, shows that God puts all sin on an equal level.
