Can Born-Again Christians be Unborn.

CAN BORN-AGAIN CHRISTIANS BE UNBORN: The expression, 'born again,' carries the idea, a change of mind, in a Christian sense, it means a change of worldview, and of religion, to a new worldview and new religion, in a Jewish sense, it means, changing from the covenant of law to the covenant of grace. When a sinner is saved, they are born again into a new life in Christ, this is a correct and a true statement, but, many in the Christian faith believe once a sinner is born again, they cannot be unborn, and are therefore saved forever.

The primary reason many believe once a sinner is born again, they cannot be unborn is because they liken it to a natural birth, and the reality, once a baby is born, it cannot be unborn, this of course is a true statement. But the birth of a natural baby is a physical birth, so of course it cannot be unborn, whereas, the new birth of a Christian, is a spiritual birth, brough about by faith, and dependant upon the believer remaining in faith. Since this is a spiritual birth, that is dependent upon the born-again believer enduring in faith, it is an error to state, they cannot be unborn, for their birth is not a physical birth, but a spiritual birth dependent upon the believer enduring in faith.

With these facts in mind, the answer to the question, can a born-again believer, be unborn, is yes, they can, by deliberately and consciously denying Christ, and forsaking their faith, to go back to the things of the world, for neither God nor the Lord Jesus Christ will force themselves upon anyone, as the following words of Jesus show:

• Everyone who acknowledges me before men, I also will acknowledge before my Father who is in heaven, but whoever denies me before men, I also will deny before my Father who is in heaven. (Matthew 10:32-33).

In contrast to those born again who do not endure in faith, the faithful in Christ who are enduring in faith, can be fully confident, that if they remain in faith they are saved, and the Lord they love and who loves them will accept them on the glorious day of the resurrection.
