Eve a Beautiful Tree and Deception.

When Jesus disciples asked him what will be the signs of your coming and of the end of the age, he warned them saying:

- See that no one leads you astray. (Matt.24:4).

And the apostle Paul warned:

- See to it that no one takes you captive by philosophy and empty deceit, according to human tradition, according to the elemental spirits of the world, and not according to Christ. (Col. 2:8).

Eve, the mother of all mankind was the first to be deceived, from her deception we can learn the following important lesson, the tree she ate of did not appear harmful, corrupted, or poisonous in any way, if it had she would never have eaten of it, but rather when she looked at it, she saw a tree that was:

- Good for food.
- A delight to the eyes.
- A tree that was to be desired to make one wise.
- **Genesis 3:6:** So, when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was a delight to the eyes, and that the tree was to be desired to make one wise, she took of its fruit and ate, and she also gave some to her husband who was with her, and he ate.

Likewise, all temptations will come to us in the same way, many think the two horned beast like a lamb, that speaks like a dragon, (Rev. 13:11), will appear as someone abhorrent, horrible, and unpleasant, because he is described as a beast and dragon, but this is not so, especially since, if he appeared this way, he would not deceive a great portion of the world's population. This man will:

- Be a great orator.
- Speak deceptive messages that appeal to the world.
- Make false promises.
- Appear to have answers that will make the world a better and safer place.

He is referred to as a two horned beast that speaks like a dragon, because he leads people away from Christ, away from the truth of God's word, and eventually brings destruction. This same principle applies to the ten horned beast empire (Rev. 13:1), it will also appear to have the will, the authority, and the power to bring peace to earth and save the planet. This is because the underlying foundation of this beast will be driven by the spirit of humanism, meaning, the well-being of mankind and the planet, which are good things, and what we all wished was the motivation of our governments, which is why a vast majority of the world's population will see the beast and its government and political rule as a good thing, and believe they have the potential to bring peace to earth and save our planet from destruction.

- The man of lawlessness (man of sin in KJV) (2 Thess. 2:3)

Combined-together these entities will be the embodiment and final manifestation of Satan disguising himself as an angel of light. (2 Corinthians 11:14).
