False Prophets, Ministers, and Super Apostles.

The following verses are the only three verses in the Bible that use the expression, "the false prophet:"

- Revelation 16:13-14: I saw, coming out of the mouth of the dragon and out of the mouth
 of the beast and out of the mouth of the *false prophet*, three unclean spirits like frogs.

 14For they are demonic spirits, performing signs, who go abroad to the kings of the whole
 world, to assemble them for battle on the great day of God the Almighty.
- Revelation 19:20: The beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought
 miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast,
 and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning
 with brimstone.
- Revelation 20:10: The devil (the spirit of the false prophet see Rev 19:20) that deceived
 them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet
 are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

These verses show that the false prophet does miracles before the beast; deceives the kings of the earth; speaks things that are an offence to God; is identified with the dragon and the beast, and both the false prophet and the beast are cast into the lake of fire.

Jesus said:

- False prophets, come in sheep's clothing but inwardly are ravenous wolves (Matt. 7:15).
- Many false prophets will arise and lead many astray (Matt. 24:11).
- False christs and false prophets will arise and perform great signs and wonders, so as to lead astray, if possible, even the elect (the faithful) (Matt. 24:24) (Mark 13:22).
- People speak well of the false prophets (Luke 6:26).

Peter wrote:

- False prophets arose among the people, just as there will be false teachers among you, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Master who bought them, bringing upon themselves swift destruction. ²And many will follow their sensuality, and because of them the way of truth will be blasphemed. ³And in their greed they will exploit you with false words (2 Peter 2:1-3).
- While they feast with those who follow them they spread their deceptions, their eyes full of adultery and sensuality and they entice unsteady souls. Their hearts full of greed and because of this they have forsaking the right way because they love the gain and benefits they get from wrongdoing (i.e., not teaching the truth and not doing the right thing) (2 Peter 2:13-15).

John warned the faithful:

• Not to believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God, for many false prophets have gone out into the world (1 John 4:1).

Paul warned the faithful of:

• Super apostles who proclaim another Jesus and a different gospel to the one the apostles proclaimed. He calls them false apostles, deceitful workmen, disguising themselves as apostles of Christ and as ministers of righteousness who pride-fully boast in their own achievements and use their followers to their own advantage. (2 Corinthians 11:4, 13, 15, 18, 20).

True apostles and minsters: the apostle Paul gives the following description of true apostles and ministers, saying they:

- Do not attempt to deceive in any way, but speak to please God and not man.
- Never use flattery to take advantage of their followers nor do they seek flattery and exaltation from them.
- Are gentle to those they have care over, like a nursing mother takes care of her own children.
- Have great affection for those under their ministry and only desire the best for them.
- Teach the Gospel, and give their own lives to benefit their flock.
- Do not allow themselves or their ministry to become a burden to any
 of those they proclaim the Gospel to.
- Live their lives in a manner that honours God and brings a good testimony to the name of the Lord Jesus Christ.
- Encourage those they teach to live in a manner worthy of God, who calls them into His own Kingdom and glory.
- Teach the Scriptures not as intellectual head knowledge, but as they really are, the word of God, which is at work in all faithful believers. (1 Thessalonians 2:3-13).

NOTICE: the beast and the false prophet are already seen in the lake of fire prior to the end of the thousand years, while the devil and Satan are cast into the lake of fire at the end of the thousand years. The lake of fire is a symbol of destruction, this is the final death (called the second death) (Rev. 2:11) (Rev. 20:6) (Rev. 20:14) (Rev. 21:8), whoever is cast into the lake of fire is punished forever. This does not mean they are cast into a pit of fire and flames, and tormented and tortured by evil entities called demons for all eternity, but that they are cast to eternal death (i.e., total extinction).
