The Gospel and Latter Days Deception.

Amongst the warnings we are given concerning the latter days, is to be on guard of deceivers and of being deceived.

- **Matthew 24:24:** Then if anyone says to you, ‘Look, here is the Christ!’ or ‘There he is!’ do not believe it. ²⁴ For false christs and false prophets will arise and perform great signs and wonders, so as to lead astray, if possible, even the elect.
- **2 Thessalonians 2:1–12:** Now concerning the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our being gathered together to him, we ask you, brothers, ² not to be quickly shaken in mind or alarmed, either by a spirit or a spoken word, or a letter seeming to be from us, to the effect that the day of the Lord has come. ³ Let no one deceive you in any way.

The error of these deceptive and destructive doctrines will not be blatantly obvious (especially in the latter days), except to those who know and understand the Scriptures, since they will not only be spoken by:

- Those who have great authority and influence.
- Those who are gifted with brilliant skilful oratory.
- Those who lift Scriptures out of context to build doctrines that appeal to pride, ego, and self, to enlarge their congregations, their fame, riches, and importance.

And most likely include:

- Justification by works and adhering to holy days, ceremonial rites, and religious customs.
- Forgiveness of sin by confessing to human priests etc.
- Superstitious teaching, praying to Mary and the dead that the Roman Papal Church has exalted to sainthood.
- Doctrines that appeal to self, ego, pride, and promise prosperity, healing, and success.
- Global followings and churches worldwide.
