The Gospel Carried to All the World by an Angel.

• Revelation 14:6-7: Then I saw another angel flying directly overhead, with an eternal gospel to proclaim to those who dwell on earth, to every nation and tribe and language and people. ⁷ And he said with a loud voice, "Fear God and give him glory, because the hour of his judgment has come, and worship him who made heaven and earth, the sea and the springs of water."

It is because God loves mankind that Jesus gave his life to redeem us from sin and death. Jesus said:

• For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. (John 3:16).

The Gospel is referred to as, 'the two-edged sword of the Spirit,' this is because it gives those who hear it the power to choose life or death, and for this reason can be seen as the sword of the Spirit, going out into all the world to separate those who choose life from those who chose death.

The angel flying with the eternal gospel: signifies the masses of faithful and zealous ministers, evangelist and followers of Christ proclaiming the Gospel worldwide. Keep in mind, the time-period, is, 'the hour of judgment,' which means two things:

- There will have been widespread wars, disasters, violence and global confusion and chaos.
- 2. Multitudes will be open to hear the Gospel.

Flying directly overhead: most likely carries the idea that despite the authority and power of the ungodly antichristian beast nations, faithful and zealous ministers, evangelist, and followers of Christ proclaim the Gospel amongst all nations, both to Jews and the Gentiles, even in the lands and countries that the governments of the ungodly antichristian ten horned beast nations are seated in. During the period, of the final antichristian beast nations, and the false prophet, powerful religious and skilful persuasive orators will proclaim a false, worldly, and deceptive gospel, and make vain promises, that will seduce and influence multitudes to exalt the anti-Christion ten horned beast empire

However, at the same time, the true eternal Gospel will go out (i.e., fly overhead), despite the antichristian world and the false prophet, as it has done from generation to generation. The going out of the Gospel into the world during this anti-Christian era is symbolised by the swift flight of the angel soaring over the heads of the anti-Christian beast empire. The idea is that no matter how strong the hostility toward God, Christ and his followers, nothing will stop the true Gospel message going out into the world, for it is the great means whereby mankind is brought to accept Christ, and be set free from sin and judgment, or to deny Christ and remain in sin and be condemned.

Whoever sets their heart upon the beast empire, and promotes their cause will forever be condemned. In contrast to this, those who die in the service of Christ will be found in Christ, and should death come, be raised to eternal life and everlasting happiness. The Gospel is called everlasting and eternal for the following four reasons:

1. Its great truths have always existed, and it proclaims an eternal truth.

- 2. Unlike the teachings of men, it will forever remain unchanged.
- 3. Its saving effects upon the heart will be everlasting.
- 4. It announces the everlasting Kingdom of Christ.

To every nation, and kindred: these words embrace all classes and races of people without any distinction whether a king or pauper, a priest or one of the masses, rich or poor, noble, or lowly the Gospel will make no distinction, it will be preached to all people with equality, without any reference to their status, their character, or their colour. This does not mean that all nations will be converted, but that all nations will have the opportunity to decide whether they will be for or against, Christ.

The time of the ten horned beast nations, is the last season of grace and for mankind to repent before judgment. If they do not, they will be as the world which resisted the preaching of Noah during the building of the arc, while the long-suffering of God patiently waited, and like the people of Noah's generation, will be left without excuse. The Gospel that proclaims, "there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved." (Acts 4:12), will not be stopped from going out to the nations during the reign of the ten horned antichristian beast nations and the false prophet.

Flying directly overhead (in the midst of heaven in KJV): the expression, "in the midst of heaven," signifies God's presence in the midst of the great congregation of the faithful global church, the body of Christ, and in the midst of all who preach the Gospel, the message of the bloodstained cross Calvary, and of salvation, from an attitude of compassion and loving kindness as Jesus had done before them.

It is from the multitudes of faithful, passionate, and zealous believers such as these that the word of the Lord will go forth to all nations, for with great passion and love for Christ they will overcome any fear of man, and openly and publicly preach the Gospel with such great boldness, that it can be rightly said, "it will swiftly spread through the air," meaning by the voices of multitudes.

The angel flying directly overhead, with an eternal gospel, signifies multitudes of fearless and bold witnesses, proclaiming the Gospel, prior to the judgement, and it is by the sound of their voices that multitudes will accept Christ.
