HALLELUJAH, ALLELUIA AND AMEN

- **Revelation 19:4:** And the twenty-four elders and the four living creatures fell down and worshiped God who was seated on the throne, saying, "Amen. Hallelujah!" (Alleluia in KJV).

Hallelujah: is also spelled alleluia, the word hallelujah is a combination of two Hebrew words, "hallel" meaning praise, and "jah" meaning God, it is a joyful word of praise.

The word Hallelujah expresses their intense joy over what God had done and the final triumph and great victory He has achieved for the church. When the word Hallelujah is repeated many times, it expresses the intenseness of joy.

Amen: means, "Truly, so be it!" It is a word of sincere confirmation, acceptance, agreement, and approval. In the context of this verse, it expresses the twenty-four elders and the four living creatures' absolute agreement and approval of the destruction of the great enemies of the church and in the downfall of the great prostitute woman and Babylon.

- **Revelation 22:20:** He who testifies to these things says, "Surely I am coming soon." Amen. Come, Lord Jesus!

The word Amen in this context is the expression of John, the angel and the Bride, signifying their sincere heartfelt and joyful approval to the words of the Saviour that, "He would come quickly," and an utterance of a strong desire that it might be so, expressing their longing for his appearing. All in Christ should live with joyful expectation of the Lord's return and have dwelling within their mind and innermost being the constant prayer, "Amen come Lord Jesus."
