An Angel Like the Son of Man.

• **Revelation 14:14-15:** Then I looked, and behold, a white cloud, and seated on the cloud one like a son of man, with a golden crown on his head, and a sharp sickle in his hand. ¹⁵ And another angel came out of the temple, calling with a loud voice to him who sat on the cloud, "Put in your sickle, and reap, for the hour to reap has come, for the harvest of the earth is fully ripe."

This angel came out of the temple, signifying he came out from the very presence of God, which means what he said to the one sitting on the cloud would be according to the direction of God. The angels' words, "Put in your sickle, and reap, for the hour to reap has come, for the harvest of the earth is fully ripe" (i.e., the ripe and good grapes, signifying the faithful and redeemed of Christ), is not a command of the angel, but a command from God the Father given to the angel to speak to His Son (i.e., the one sitting on the cloud). The following words of Jesus show that this idea is in harmony with all New Testament Scriptures concerning God's Son, and his being in submission to His Heavenly Father to do His will and His work. Jesus said:

- God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. ¹⁷For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. (John 3:16-17)
- Truly, truly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of his own accord, but only what he sees the Father doing. For whatever the Father does, that the Son does likewise. (John 5:19)
- No one takes my life from me, but I lay it down of my own accord. I have authority to lay it down, and I have authority to take it up again. This charge I have received from my Father. (John 10:18)

- I have not spoken on my own authority, but the Father who sent me has himself given me a commandment—what to say and what to speak. (John 12:49)
- I do as the Father has commanded me, so that the world may know that I love the Father. (John 14:31)
- The revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave him to show to his servants the things that must soon take place. He made it known by sending his angel to his servant John, (Revelation 1:1).
