Angels are Fellow Servant with those in Christ.

In the book of Revelation, we read:

- Then I (John) fell down at his feet to worship him, but he said to me, “You must not do that! I am a fellow servant with you and your brothers who hold to the testimony of Jesus. Worship God.” For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy. (Rev. 19:10).

This fellow servant was an angel, yet he speaks of himself as a fellow-servant of John, meaning he was engaged in the same service and work as John, to advance the same Gospel and message of salvation, and to honour the same Redeemer.

In the Book of Hebrews, God says, He makes His angels winds, and His ministers a flame of fire, and that they are all ministering spirits sent out to serve for the sake of those who are to inherit salvation? (Heb. 1:7-8, 14). This shines a spotlight upon the truth that we are working together with the angels to bring about the fulfillment of God’s eternal plans and purposes.

SNAPSHOT: the angel told John not to worship him, because even though he was far more powerful than John in nature, he was his equal in service to God. This should give all the faithful great encouragement, since it means that it matters not if we are a believer faithfully doing the mundane duties in service to God or a believer preaching to a congregation of thousands, God counts both equal in service. Since proclaiming the Gospel is about delivering sinners from death to life and extending the Kingdom of Christ it is easy to see why the apostles and faithful ministers are sometimes in Scripture referred to as angels. (i.e., the angels of the seven churches, can also be taken to refer to the ministers of the seven churches).
