Blood Flowed as High as a Horses Bridle 1600 Stadia.

• Revelation 14:20: And the winepress was trodden outside the city, and blood flowed from the winepress, as high as a horse's bridle, for 1,600 stadia (one thousand and six hundred furlongs in the KJV).

The word furlong comes from the Greek word, (stadia and histemi). Stadia means fixed, or a certain measure of distance, and by implication a stadium or race-course, while the word histemi means to stand, abide, appoint, bring, continue, establish, hold up and set up. The expression, "the blood flowed as high as a horse's bridle, for 1,600 stadia," is a hyperbole (i.e., exaggerated speech) used to highlight the greatness of death and carries the following ideas:

- During this time there will be great slaughter.
- The space of a thousand and six hundred furlongs; is a hyperbolical expression, setting forth the largeness and universality of the destruction of the wicked, and the impossibility of their escaping it.

It is very likely, that this great battle refers to the place called Armageddon.

• **Revelation 16:16:** And they assembled them at the place that in Hebrew is called Armageddon.

It is here at Armageddon where the antichristian ten horned beast and those who received its mark and worshipped its image and the false prophet are captured and thrown into the lake of fire.

• Revelation 19:20: And the beast was captured, and with it the false prophet who in its presence had done the signs by which he deceived those who had received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped its image. These two were thrown alive into the lake of fire that burns with sulfur.

However, since the chapter contains many symbols, it is difficult to determine anything with absolute certainty except that Christ and his church will be triumphantly victorious and their enemies utterly overthrown and destroyed.
