Overview of Pauls Gospel in Colossians.

INTRODUCTION: since some in the body of Christ believe a repentant sinner seeking God, must understand the Old and New Testament before they can be saved and water baptised. This study gives a brief overview of each of Paul's letters focusing upon the Gospel the Lord Jesus Christ gave to him on the road to Damascus, and in various visions to proclaim to the Gentiles, to discover if they contain enough information for a sinner seeking God to be saved.

NOTE: since some chapters containing Paul's letters are solely focused on rules for those in Christ to live by, and various teachings, but have nothing directly concerning Paul's Gospel, they have been skipped.

COLOSSIANS 1

God appointed Paul to proclaim:

- The word of truth of the Gospel and the grace of God, and the hope laid up in heaven for those who remain steadfast in love. (Col. 1:3-6).
- The mystery hidden for generations, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory, and that through faith in the Lord Jesus Christ those alienated from God can now be reconciled to Him. (Col. 1:26-28).
- The hope of the Gospel that has been proclaimed in all creation under heaven, referring to, the mystery hidden for generations, which is Christ in you, and the resurrection. (Col. 1:26-28).
- All in Christ who continue steadfast in faith can stand before God holy blameless and above reproach (Col. 1:21-23), and that through the truth of the Gospel God delivers sinners from the domain of darkness and transfers them into the Kingdom of His beloved Son. (Col. 1:13-14).
- In God's Son sinners have redemption, and the forgiveness of sins, it was Paul's goal to present everyone mature in Christ.

COLOSSIANS 2

God established the faith of all who received the Lord Jesus Christ, and appointed Paul to proclaim:

- The knowledge of God's mystery, which is; all the hidden treasures of wisdom and knowledge are in Christ, and that in Christ the whole fullness of deity dwells. (Col. 2:2-3).
- God raised Jesus from the dead, and that he is the head of all rule and authority. (Col. 2:9).
- Those who have been buried with Christ in the waters of baptism, have through faith been raised with him, and through faith put off the body of flesh. Water baptism signifies literal death and resurrection, when we physically die, and are raised, the body of sin remains in the grave. This is what water baptism signifies, it means we are united to God, while the body of sin is by faith dead. (Col. 2:12-3).

- Through Jesus death God has forgiven all sins and trespasses of all who are redeemed in Christ, and united them to Himself by canceling the record of debt that stood against them with its legal demands (i.e., religious regulations, holy days, and ceremonial rites etc.), because they have no value in stopping the indulgence of the flesh or saving anyone. (Col. 2:13-14).

COLOSSIANS 3

God appointed Paul to proclaim:

- Christ is seated at the right hand of God, and that those who have been raised with him through water of baptism are to seek and set their minds on things that are above, and not on things that are on earth. (Col. 3:1-2).
- The life of those who have died through the waters of baptism, is hidden with Christ in God, but when Christ who is their life appears, then they will appear with him in glory. (Col. 3:3-4).

Those who have through faith died with Christ are to put off the old self with its:

- Sexual immorality, impurity, and evil desire.
- Covetousness (which is idolatry), lying and deception.
- Anger, wrath, malice, slander, and obscene talk.

It is because of these sinful attitudes, behavior and action being rampant throughout the world, the wrath of God is coming. Those who have through faith died with Christ are to put on the new self which is being renewed in knowledge after the image of its creator.
