The Cup of Wine of God's Fury and Wrath.

• Revelation 16:19: The great city was split into three parts, and the cities of the nation's fell, and God remembered Babylon the great, to make her drain the cup of the wine of the fury of his wrath (to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath in KJV).

In this chapter the wrath of God is poured out upon:

- The earth and the beast. (v1-2).
- The sea and the rivers. (v4-5).
- The sun (i.e., affecting the earth with great heat and fires). (v8).
- The seat of the beast, and his kingdom. (v10).
- The great river Euphrates, so that its water dried up (signifying the loss of great power). (v12).
- The dragon the beast, and the false prophet. (v13).

This means the wrath of God is poured out upon the entire globe of the earth and all that is upon it.

The expression, "to give unto her the cup of wine," means, to punish and destroy her. It carries the idea that the sins and evil of the world have reached such an extreme peak that the justice, judgment, and wrath of God cannot be withheld any longer. The false doctrines, that the Roman Papal Church has corrupted the world with and the ungodly antichristian ten horned beast powers aggressive hostility toward Christ can be tolerated no longer.

The wrath of God is sometimes signified in the Old Testament by a wine cup, and a cup of fury.

Psalm 75:8: In the hand of the LORD there is a cup with foaming wine, well mixed, and
he pours out from it, and all the wicked of the earth shall drain it down to the dregs.

Here the exceeding greatness of God's wrath is expressed by a foaming cup of wine. The following verses also speak of God's wrath.

- Isaiah 51:17: Wake yourself, wake yourself, stand up, O Jerusalem, you who have drunk from the hand of the LORD the cup of his wrath, who have drunk to the dregs the bowl, the cup of staggering.
- Isaiah 51:22: Thus says your Lord, the LORD, your God who pleads the cause of his people: "Behold, I have taken from your hand the cup of staggering; the bowl of my wrath you shall drink no more.
- **Jeremiah 25:15:** Thus the LORD, the God of Israel, said to me: "Take from my hand this cup of the wine of wrath, and make all the nations to whom I send you drink it.
- Revelation 14:10: He also will drink the wine of God's wrath, poured full strength into the cup of his anger, and he will be tormented with fire and sulfur in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb.
- Revelation 16:19: The great city was split into three parts, and the cities of the nation's
 fell, and God remembered Babylon the great, to make her drain the cup of the wine of the
 fury of his wrath.

• Revelation 18:6: Pay her back as she herself has paid back others, and repay her double for her deeds; mix a double portion for her in the cup she mixed.

The woman here refers to the woman adorned with gold, jewels and pearls who has in her hand a golden cup full of abominations and the impurities of sexual immorality. (Rev. 17:4).
