Although I believe my aim is pure and God's will perfect this document is still the product of a human man, as to such I neither claim perfect knowledge or perfect understanding.

Egypt, Assyria and Israel will Worship Together.

In Isaiah chapter nineteen Isaiah one of the Bible's greatest prophets prophesied that a time would come when Egypt will not only have a fierce king rule over them, but all their leaders will be fools. The people of the nation will be full of confusion and fight and war amongst themselves city against city so much so that the nation is likened to a drunken man staggering in his own vomit. They will suffer poverty; lack of food and their land and water will be polluted. When all these things come to pass Isaiah in his vision sees the LORD coming to Egypt riding on a swift cloud and the heart of the Egyptians melting in fear at his presence.

When that day comes Isaiah prophesies:

- The Egyptians will tremble with fear before the LORD and the land of Judah will become a terror to the Egyptians (v16-17).
- There will be five cities in the land of Egypt that will swear allegiance to the LORD one of which is called the City of Destruction (v18).
- There will be altars built to the LORD in the midst of the land of Egypt to witness that the LORD is in the land of Egypt (v19).
- When the people of Egypt cry to the LORD because of oppressors, he will send them a saviour and defender and deliver them (v20).
- The LORD will make himself known to the Egyptians and the Egyptians will know the LORD (v19-21).
- Egypt will worship and make vows to the LORD and perform them (v20).
- Egypt will return to the LORD and he will listen to their pleas for mercy and heal them (v22).
- There will be a highway from Egypt to Assyria, and Assyria will come into Egypt, and Egypt into Assyria, and the Egyptians will worship with the Assyrians (v23).
- Israel will be the third with Egypt and Assyria, a blessing in the midst of the earth (v24).
- The LORD will bless Egypt, Assyria and Israel, saying, "Blessed be Egypt my people, and Assyria the work of my hands, and Israel my inheritance" (v25).

THE RETURN OF CHRIST

The following is a brief scenario that will shine some light upon when the final climax of these events will take place. The Lord Jesus Christ will return as, King of kings and Lord of lords (Rev. 19:11-16) to rule and reign from God's Holy City Jerusalem (on Mount Zion God's Holy Mountain) to establish God's Kingdom on earth during his millennial reign. Jesus will do justice to the poor and oppressed, he will be a faithful and compassionate King forever. He will not allow anyone to strike terror in the earth, or use lies and deception to enlarge their own wealth and power. The land will abundantly produce and even the deserts will flourish. The animals will not feed on each other and even the lamb will be able to lie down with the wolf and everyone will eat of their own hands because all that they plant will produce. All nations the LORD has made will come and worship before the Lord Jesus Christ. They will glorify God's Name, proclaiming the LORD is great and does wondrous things and that He alone is God. The book of Revelation states:

- Jesus Christ, the faithful witness who loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood has made us kings and priests unto God and his Father is coming in glory and every eye shall see him, and they also who pierced him and all kindreds of the earth (Revelation 1:5-7).

And in Revelation chapter five we are told that:

- Christ was slain, and by his blood he redeemed a people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation and made them a kingdom and priests to God and they shall reign on the earth (Revelation 5:9-10).
