INTRODUCTION: in the book of Exodus, God fulfilled His promise to Abraham by multiplying Abraham's descendants into a great nation delivering them from slavery in Egypt to journey to the Promised Land, and then binding them to Himself with a covenant at Mount Sinai. Moses, under the direct command of God and as leader of Israel, received the Ten Commandments from God, along with other laws governing Israel's life and worship. He also led the nation in building the Tabernacle, a place where God's presence can dwell among his people and where they can make sacrifices for sin. Most Jews and Christians recognise Moses as the author, writing sometime after the Exodus from Egypt (about 1445 B.C.). Note: the promise God made to Abraham will be perfectly fulfilled when Christ returns in glory and all those (Jews and Gentiles) who belong to God's Kingdom are gathered to him. God promises that He will bring Israel out of Egypt and into the land He promised to give to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob and that He will drive Israel out of Pharaoh's land with a strong hand.

God's promise to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob:

God spoke to Moses and said to him, "I am the LORD. ³I appeared to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, as God Almighty, but by my name the LORD. I did not make myself known to them. ⁴I also established my covenant with them to give them the land of Canaan, the land in which they lived as sojourners (Exod. 6:2-4).

God's promise to Israel:

 The LORD tells Moses to say to Israel that He will bring them out of Egypt and into the land He Promised to give to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob and give the land to Israel for a possession. Israel will be His people and the LORD will know that the LORD is their God.

Moses spoke to the people of Israel, but they did not listen to him because of their broken spirit then the LORD tells Moses to go and tell Pharaoh the King of Egypt to let the people of Israel go out of his land, but Moses says to the LORD if the people of Israel will no longer listen to him why would Pharaoh listen to him?

Eleazar: Aaron's son took as his wife one of the daughters of Putiel, and she bore him Phinehas.

These are the heads of the fathers' houses of the Levites (Exod. 6:25) and the generations of Aaron and Moses to whom the LORD said, "Bring out the people of Israel from the land of Egypt (Exod. 6:26-30).
