The Gospel in a Nutshell.

Throughout the generations there have always been those who have a vast knowledge of the Bible (a great blessing), but this does not mean, those who do not have the same level of knowledge are lacking in faith, because, no one needs to be a Bible encyclopaedia, before being saved and water baptised, for the knowledge of the Gospel of salvation, and message of the cross of Calvary, that leads to eternal life is plain for all to understand, for it proclaims, whoever:

- Believes Jesus is the Son of God, and Saviour of the world, and with a humble heart, and honest repentance, by faith accept Jesus as their Saviour.
- 2. Is water baptised.
- 3. Believes, they are saved by grace, and not by any worth in themselves, but by Christ's righteousness being imputed (i.e., credited) to them.
- 4. Believe Jesus died and rose again, and will return to gather the faithful to himself and to eternal life.
- 5. Faithfully follow Christ and aim to bring honour to God, and a good testimony to the name of Jesus and the Christian faith.

Have been delivered from the domain of darkness and transferred into the kingdom of God's beloved Son. (Colossians 1:10–13). Immediately after a believer had been water baptised into Christ, the pattern of the Early church, was to fellowship together as brothers and sisters in Christ and share the knowledge of the Scriptures that they had with each other, and in this way, they continued to grow together in the fruits of the Spirit and increase in:

- The knowledge of the Scriptures (Old and New Testament).
- The knowledge of God and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- The knowledge of God's love and grace in Christ.

Sadly, some believe a repentant sinner must have a clear knowledge of the Bible from Genesis to Revelation before they can be water baptised, but this is not the Bible pattern, for even the lowliest of Adam, can understand the path to salvation, this is the beauty of the New Covenant, and the Christian message that leads to eternal life.
