Jacinth.

The colour of the jacinth stone can be various colours:

- White
- Orange
- Violet (bluish-purple)
- Yellow
- Ruby red
- Blue
- Grey
- Black
- Pinkish

Nowadays, jacinth is considered, to be golden to red-brown and reddish blue or deep purple. It is the first stone mentioned in the Bible in the third row of the priest's breastplate:

- **Exodus 28:19:** and the third row a jacinth, an agate, and an amethyst.

And the eleventh of the twelve precious stones used in the New Jerusalem:

- **Revelation 21:20:** the fifth onyx, the sixth carnelian, the seventh chrysolite, the eighth beryl, the ninth topaz, the tenth chrysoptase, the eleventh jacinth, the twelfth amethyst.

In ancient times jacinth was believed to:

- Protect the wearer from plagues, pestilence, and lightning.
- Strengthen the heart, and bring wealth, honor, and wisdom.

It is supposed by some that biblically, Jacinth signifies those who can impart wisdom to mature believers, because they have understanding and discernment of wisdom.
