JESUS IN THE MIDST OF GOLDEN LAMPSTANDS

- **Revelation 1:13:** and in the midst of the lampstands (golden candlesticks in KJV) one like a son of man, clothed with a long robe and with a golden sash around his chest.

The following verses show the lampstands signify the seven churches:

- **Revelation 1:20:** As for the mystery of the seven stars that you saw in my right hand, and the seven golden lampstands, the seven stars are the angels of the seven churches, and the seven lampstands are the seven churches.

Jesus being in, the midst of the lampstands carries the idea that he is always with his churches filling them with light, life, love, and judgment accordingly to the end of the world (as we know it).

SNAPSHOT: the King James Bible translation, "golden candlesticks," I feel is a far better translation, for the word, "golden," highlights how valuable the church is to God and how much He treasures the faithful.

JESUS CLOTHED WITH A LONG ROBE AND GOLDEN SASH

- **Revelation 1:13:** and in the midst of the lampstands (golden candlesticks in KJV) one like a son of man, clothed with a long robe and with a golden sash around his chest.

Clothed with a long robe and with a golden sash, signifies Christ's kingly and priestly dignity and his righteousness and priesthood, as Mediator. It carries the idea that he was fully clothed with righteousness and the royal majesty and glory of God his heavenly Father. The golden sash, around his chest, signifies the precious love and affection he has for his people.

THE HAIRS OF JESUS HEAD WHITE AS WOOL AND SNOW

- **Revelation 1:14:** His head and *his* hairs *were* white like wool, as white as snow; and his eyes *were* as a flame of fire;

The hairs of his head were white like wool, this signifies the absolute purity of Christ, and that his whole being is filled with light. It carries the idea that his entire body is without blemish and full of the perfect holiness, and righteousness of God.

JESUS EYES AS FLAMES OF FIRE

- **Revelation 1:14:** His head and *his* hairs *were* white like wool, as white as snow; and his eyes *were* as a flame of fire;

His eyes were like a flame of fire, signifies the following two things:

1. Jesus can perceive and pierce even the hardest of hearts, nothing can be hidden from him, no secret thought, or hidden action or motive of the heart can be kept secret from the eyes of the Lord.
2. When the words, "eyes like flames of fire," are added, it signifies, wrath and judgement, and denotes that he sees all kinds of evil and will judge accordingly.

JESUS FEET LIKE BURNISHED BRONZE REFINED IN A FURNACE

- **Revelation 1:15:** his feet were like burnished bronze, refined in a furnace, and his voice was like the roar of many waters.

His feet were like burnished bronze, refined in a furnace, signify Christ's exalted power to tread down his enemies and consume them. It carries the idea that he is, able to judge with perfect judgment and will not let the guilty, the wicked and the corrupt go free.

JESUS VOICE LIKE THE ROAR OF MANY WATERS

- **Revelation 1:15:** his feet were like burnished bronze, refined in a furnace, and his voice was like the roar of many waters.

The symbolism of the words, "his voice was like the roar of many waters" can be applied to the following:

- The waves of the ocean, during a storm roaring and cashing upon the rocks of a cliff or on the shore of a beach.
- The roaring waters of a waterfall crashing down on the waters below.
- The waters of a river during a flood, rapidly flowing over the banks and stones of a river.

This words, "his voice was like the roar of many waters," signifies the following two things:

1. The power and authority of the voice of Christ and the Gospel, as preached by his apostles and ministers, which was heard far and near and which did make a great noise in the world.
 - **Romans 10:18:** I ask, have they not heard? Indeed they have, for "Their voice has gone out to all the earth, and their words to the ends of the world."

By extension it also embraces the voice of every faithful brother and sister in Christ of every generation who has testified to the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ and have been and still are his faithful witness.

2. The power of Christ's word and his voice pronouncing judgment and vengeance on his enemies to destroy all that is offensive to his Heavenly Father.

JESUS RIGHT HAND HELD THE SEVEN STARS

- **Revelation 1:16:** In his right hand he held seven stars, from his mouth came a sharp two-edged sword, and his face was like the sun shining in full strength.

The following verse shows that the seven stars, that the one like a son of man, held in his right-hand are the angels of the seven churches.

- **Revelation 1:20:** As for the mystery of the seven stars that you saw in my right hand, and the seven golden lampstands, the seven stars are the angels of the seven churches, and the seven lampstands are the seven churches.

Stars shine bright in darkness, in the context of these verses they are emblems of the seven ministers and churches that existed at the time of John, but by extension signify all ministers of churches, filled with the

Spirit of Christ who under his authority and by his authority bring his light into this world of darkness. The stars by extension also embrace the churches themselves.

JESUS MOUTH LIKE A SHARP TWO-EDGED SWORD

- **Revelation 1:16:** In his right hand he held seven stars, from his mouth came a sharp two-edged sword, and his face was like the sun shining in full strength.

The words, "from his mouth came a sharp two-edged sword, signifies the following two things:

1. Christ's word going out into the world and dividing what is of God and what is not, and judging accordingly.
2. God word discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart. (Hebrews 4:12).
3. The power of Christ's word to save to eternal life or destroy to eternal death. This power is magnified by the symbolism of the sword having two sharp edges and coming from his mouth.

JESUS FACE LIKE THE SUN SHINING IN FULL STRENGTH

- **Revelation 1:16:** In his right hand he held seven stars, from his mouth came a sharp two-edged sword, and his face was like the sun shining in full strength.

The words, "Jesus' face was like the sun shining in full strength is most likely taken from the dazzling rays of the sun when they shine so brightly that they are too intense and bright for mortal eyes to behold. The expression is used to magnify the greatness, the magnitude, and excellency of Christ's glory and carries the idea that the immortal and eternal glory of Christ is breathtakingly glorious.
