The following beautiful words of Paul are awe-inspiring and should be enormously comforting to all who fully depend upon faith in Christ and on God's grace for their salvation.

• Galatians 2:21: I do not nullify the grace of God, for if righteousness were through the law, then Christ died for no purpose. The King James Bible says, I do not frustrate the grace of God: for if righteousness *come* by the law, then Christ is dead in vain.

This means, when a brother or sister in Christ begins to justify themselves through the law, or in any other way, they nullify the grace of God, and by their actions declare that Christ's death was of no value. To highlight this truth even more Paul went on to say:

• Galatians 5:4: (ESV) You are severed from Christ, you who would be justified by the law; you have fallen away from grace. The King James Bible, says: Christ is become of no effect unto you, whosoever of you are justified by the law; ye are fallen from grace.

This means, the instant a believer forsakes grace, they separate themselves from Christ, supporting this even more, Paul in the following verses emphasis the truth, we are only saved by grace.

• Ephesians 2:5: even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved. The King James Bible, says: Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved).

Here the boundless breath, height and depth of God's grace is manifested, He made us alive with Christ, while we were sinners.

• **Ephesians 2:8:** For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God.

Here the boundless breath, height and depth of God's grace is manifested, in the following words, "He made us alive with Christ, while we were sinners." This verse contains two truths, that shine a brilliant light upon the beauty and glory of Christian salvation:

- 1. It is not dependent upon works, but upon grace.
- 2. Salvation is a gift of God.

Paul in these verses is shining a brilliant floodlight on the truth that every brother and sister in Christ is saved, solely by faith and by grace and it is not their own doing, but the gift of God. This means that without grace no-one can be united to Christ, and whoever is without Christ is separated from God, and without God no-one can be saved to eternal life, which means, in regards to eternal salvation the following four:

- 1. Christ.
- 2. God.
- 3. Grace.
- 4. Faith.

Should all be given the highest priority, when preaching the Gospel, for no-one can be saved to eternal life without any one of them.
