INTRODUCTION: to get an idea of where the awesome and breathtaking events spoken of in Revelation chapter nineteen fit in God's prophetic timetable we will firstly take a brief look at the events that have transpired prior to these prophetic and eternal events unfolding.

Revelation Seventeen: tells us Jesus will return as Lord of lords and King of kings and conquer a woman full of abominations and adorned with gold, jewels and pearls (symbolic of global false religion) sitting on a scarlet beast full of blasphemous names (symbolic of the global secular world system) because both the woman and the beast are of one mind to make war on Christ.

Revelation Eighteen: records the fall of Babylon the Great who the kings and the merchants of the earth grew rich from the power of her global banking and financial system of credit, interest, greed and excessive profits and thereby corrupted the earth with self-indulgent luxurious living and immorality.

Revelation Nineteen: now in this chapter Jesus descends on a white horse as King of kings and Lord of lords with great power and God by His mighty power destroys the armies of the nations who attempted to destroy Jesus and those gathered to him and the birds of the air feast on the dead bodies.

The King of kings and Lord of lords.

Revelation 19:11-16 -- ¹¹Then I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse! The one sitting on it is called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he judges and makes war. ¹²His eyes are like a flame of fire, and on his head are many diadems, and he has a name written that no one knows but himself. ¹³He is clothed in a robe dipped in blood, and the name by which he is called is The Word of God. ¹⁴the armies of heaven, in fine linen, white and pure, were following him on white horses. ¹⁵From his mouth comes a sharp sword to strike down the nations, and he will rule them with a rod of iron. He will tread the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God the Almighty. ¹⁶On his robe and on his thigh he has a name written, *King of kings and Lord of lords*.

Jesus is returning in glory to earth as King of kings and Lord of lords for the following two reasons: -

1. To avenge God's people who have suffered and been persecuted by Babylon the Great (also called, Mystery, Babylon the Great, the Mother of Harlots and Abominations of the Earth) (Rev.17:5) (Rev. 19:2).
1. To establish God's Kingdom of righteousness, justice, joy and peace on earth.

John in his vision sees Jesus returning with his armies. This most likely refers to that moment when the ruler of this world gathers the armies of the nation's to make war against Christ and against those who have been gathered by the power of God to him (Rev. 19:19).

Jesus and those with him do not actually enter into a battle because God from heaven miraculously destroys the armies who come against Christ. The return of Jesus is very similar to when he appeared on earth the first time, the religious leaders of his generation were threatened by the tremendous success he was having in building God's Kingdom, they not only envied his power, but feared they would lose theirs so they plotted to have him murdered, by enticing the Romans to crucify him.

It is certain when the false religious leaders of this world see Jesus ruling from God's Holy City Jerusalem and gaining enormous power (especially over the Middle East) and a worldwide following they and the super-rich well once again feel threatened by Jesus tremendous success and fear they are going to lose the great power and control they hold over the global world so in the same manner that the prideful self-serving religious rulers enticed the Romans to destroy Christ, they will this time entice the armies of the nations to destroy him. Only this time Jesus is not coming as the Lamb to be slain, but the mighty King of kings and Lord of lords to rule and reign until all enemies are put under his feet.

The Great Supper of God

Revelation 19:17 ----- ¹⁷Then I saw an angel standing in the sun, and with a loud voice he called to all the birds that fly directly overhead, "Come, gather for the *Great Supper of God* ¹⁸to eat the flesh of kings, the flesh of captains, the flesh of mighty men, the flesh of horses and their riders, and the flesh of all men, both free and slave, both small and great." ¹⁹And I saw the beast and the kings of the earth with their armies gathered to make war against him who was sitting on the horse and against his army. ²¹And the rest were slain by the sword that came from the mouth of him who was sitting on the horse, and all the birds were gorged with their flesh.

The war between the nations and Jesus results in the armies of the world's nations being miraculously conquered by Christ and naturally results as every war does in the bodies of hundreds of dead soldiers lying on the surface of the earth. Since this battle between the Kingdom of men and the Kingdom of God is so great there is, not enough people available to bury the multitudes of dead bodies of the defeated armies who attempted to make war against Christ. Vultures and all kinds of flesh eating birds quickly appear on the horrific and blood stained scene and feast of the dead and decaying bodies. This is the Great Supper of God that the birds of the air are called to.

The two practical reasons for this Great Supper would be: -

- 1 To rid the earth of all the dead and decaying bodies of the defeated armies of the nations who in enormous pride and extreme arrogance attempted to make war with Jesus and those who have by the power of God been gathered to him.
2. To stop deadly diseases from spreading.

After God from heaven by his mighty power has destroyed the armies who came against Jesus and those gathered to him. Jesus full of all wisdom and a master of oratory makes speeches full of healing to the remaining civilian populations of the nations, these speeches result in the people of the world willing submitting to Christ's Kingly rule (at least for the earlier half of this glorious millennial age).

The millennial age: when Jesus returns in glory as, King of kings and Lord of lords (Rev. 19:11-16) to rule and reign from God's Holy City Jerusalem (on Mount Zion God's Holy Mountain) to establish God's Kingdom on earth during his glorious millennial reign. In the first resurrection (Rev. 20:4-6) the dead in Christ and the faithful, who are alive, will be gathered together to rule and reign as kings and priests with the Lord over those nations who are left outside the Holy City of God. Christ the King united with his people will not only bring peace to the Middle East, but establish God's Kingdom of steadfast love, faithfulness, righteousness, joy and peace throughout the world and the glory of God will cover the earth.

Jesus will do justice to the poor and oppressed, he will be a faithful and compassionate King forever. He will not allow anyone to strike terror in the earth or use lies and deception to enlarge their own wealth and power.

The land will abundantly produce and even the deserts will flourish. The animals will not feed on each other and even the lamb will be able to lie down with the wolf and everyone will eat of their own hands because all that they plant will produce. All nations the LORD has made will come and worship before the Lord Jesus Christ. They will glorify God's Name, proclaiming the LORD is great and does wondrous things and that He alone is God.

The book of Revelation states: -

- Jesus Christ, the faithful witness who loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood has made us kings and priests unto God and his Father is coming in glory and every eye shall see him, and they also who pierced him and all kindreds of the earth (Revelation 1:5-7).

And in Revelation chapter five we are told that: -

- Christ was slain, and by his blood he redeemed a people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation and made them a kingdom and priests to God and they shall reign on the earth (Revelation 5:9-10).

At the end of this glorious Kingdom age God descends to earth on a Great White Throne the sea, death and hades (the grave) give up the dead. They stand before God and are judged according to what is written in certain heavenly books according to what they have done. Death and those counted unworthy are cast into the Lake of Fire a symbol of eternal destruction (i.e., total extinction) (also called the, Second Death) (Rev. 20:11-15). Christ hands the Kingdom over to his heavenly Father and God is ALL in ALL and ETERNITY begins in all its fullness and majestic royal glory.
