- **Revelation 1:12:** Then I turned to see the voice that was speaking to me, and on turning I saw seven golden lampstands, ¹³ and in the midst of the lampstands one like a son of man, clothed with a long robe and with a golden sash around his chest.

The golden lampstands signify, Christian churches, the picture here is of Christ, walking amongst the churches, which means he walks with his people when they are gathered-together and when they are alone, by his Spirit, his word, his love, his comfort, his joy, and his grace. It also means the Lord knows everything about his people, he knows:

- Our emotional state and tribulations.
- Our devotional life, morality, and integrity.
- Our every secret though and activity.
- Our joy, pain, weakness, and strength.
