## Linen Pure and White.

---

- **Revelation 15:5-6:** John I looked, and the sanctuary of the tent of witness in heaven was opened, <sup>6</sup> and out of the sanctuary came the seven angels with the seven plagues, clothed in pure, bright linen, with golden sashes around their chests.

Prior to this verse John saw these seven angels with the seven final plagues of God's wrath.

These angels emerged from the sanctuary clothed in pure bright linen with golden sashes around their chests, which is very similar to the clothing of the Lord Jesus Christ, as the following verses show:

- **Revelation 1:13:** In the midst of the lampstands one like a son of man, clothed with a long robe and with a golden sash around his chest. (Rev. 1:13).

The seven angels are likened to Christ, because they emerge from the sanctuary, are righteous and have come forth to do His bidding. Pure and white linen is the emblem of holiness and the common representation of the heavenly inhabitants.

- **Revelation 3:3-4:** Yet you have still a few names in Sardis, people who have not soiled their garments, and they will walk with me in white, for they are worthy.
- **Revelation 7:13:** Then one of the elders addressed me, saying, "Who are these, clothed in white robes, and from where have they come?"
- **Matthew 17:2:** He was transfigured before them, and his face shone like the sun, and his clothes became white as light.
- **Luke 9:29:** He was praying, the appearance of his face was altered, and his clothing became dazzling white.
- **Mark 16:5:** Entering the tomb, they saw a young man sitting on the right side, dressed in a white robe, and they were alarmed.

Being clothed in pure and fine linen, clean and white, signifies the following two things:

1. Being clothed with the pure and spotless robe of Christ's righteousness, in contrast to being clothed with our own self-righteousness.
  2. The one clothed in white is fully and perfectly equipped in character, and righteousness for the heavenly work assigned to them.
- **Revelation 19:8:** It was granted her to clothe herself with fine linen, bright and pure"—for the fine linen is the righteous deeds of the saints. (Rev. 19:8).
