PSALMS

✓ Psalm 23:6: Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the LORD forever.

MATTHEW - DENYING JESUS RESULTS IN LOSS OF SALVATION

✓ Matthew 10:32-33: everyone who acknowledges me before men, I also will acknowledge before my Father who is in heaven, ³³ but whoever denies me before men, I also will deny before my Father who is in heaven.

THE BOOK OF JOHN

- John 1:16: For from his fullness we have all received, grace upon grace.
- **John 3:16-18:** "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. ¹⁷ For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. ¹⁸ Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God.
- **John 3:36:** Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him.
- ✓ **John 5:24:** Jesus said: Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears my word and believes in Him who sent me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgement but has passed from death into life."
- **John 10:29:** My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all, and no one is able to snatch them out of the Father's hand.

ROMANS

- Romans 3:23-25: for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, ²⁴ and are justified
 by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus.
- ✓ Romans 5:17: For if, because of one man's trespass, death reigned through that one man, much more will those who receive the abundance of grace and the free gift of righteousness reign in life through the one man Jesus Christ.
- Romans 5:20: Now the law came in to increase the trespass, but where sin increased, grace abounded all the more.
- Romans 6:14: For sin will have no dominion over you, since you are not under law but under grace.
- Romans 8:16: The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God.
- ✓ Romans 8:38 -39: For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come. Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

- ✓ Romans 10:1-3: Brothers, my heart's desire and prayer to God for them (the Jews) is that they may be saved. ² For I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to knowledge. ³ For, being ignorant of the righteousness of God, and seeking to establish their own, they did not submit to God's righteousness.
- Romans 10:4: For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes.
- Romans 10:5-8: For Moses writes about the righteousness that is based on the law, that the person who does the commandments shall live by them. ⁶ But the righteousness based on faith says, "Do not say in your heart, 'Who will ascend into heaven?' "(that is, to bring Christ down) ⁷ "or 'Who will descend into the abyss?' "(That is, to bring Christ up from the dead). ⁸ But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" (that is, the word of faith that we proclaim).
- Romans 10:9-11: if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰ For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved. ¹¹ For the Scripture says, "Everyone who believes in him will not be put to shame."
- Romans 10:13: For "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."
- ✓ Romans 11:5-6: So too at the present time there is a remnant, chosen by grace. ⁶ But if it is by grace, it is no longer on the basis of works; otherwise grace would no longer be grace.
- Romans 20:20: For by works of the law no human being will be justified in his sight, since through the law comes knowledge of sin.
- ✓ **Romans 20:23:** for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, ²⁴ and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus.
- Romans 20:28: For we hold that one is justified by faith apart from works of the law.

1 CORINTHIANS

- ✓ 1 Corinthians 3:11–15: For no one can lay a foundation other than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ. ¹² Now if anyone builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw— ¹³ each one's work will become manifest, for the Day will disclose it, because it will be revealed by fire, and the fire will test what sort of work each one has done. ¹⁴ If the work that anyone has built on the foundation survives, he will receive a reward. ¹⁵ If anyone's work is burned up, he will suffer loss, though he himself will be saved, but only as through fire.
- 1 Corinthians 6:20: For you were bought with a price: therefore, glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.
- 1 Corinthians 15:55: "O death, where is your victory? O death, where is your sting?"

GALATIANS

- ✓ Galatians 2:16: yet we know that a person is not justified by works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ, so we also have believed in Christ Jesus, in order to be justified by faith in Christ and not by works of the law, because by works of the law no one will be justified.
- ✓ Galatians 3:26: for in Christ Jesus you are all sons of God, through faith.
- ✓ Galatians 5:4: (ESV) You are severed from Christ, you who would be justified by the law; you have fallen away from grace. The King James Bible, says: Christ is become of no effect unto you, whosoever of you are justified by the law; ye are fallen from grace.

EPHESIANS

- **Ephesians 1:3:** Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ.
- Ephesians 1:4: According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love.
- **Ephesians 1:5:** Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will.
- Ephesians 1:6: To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved.
- ✓ Ephesians 1:13: In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise"
- ✓ **Ephesians 2:5:** even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved.
- ✓ **Ephesians 2:8-9:** For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, ⁹ not a result of works, so that no one may boast.
- Ephesians 4:30: And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

1 THESSALONIANS

 1 Thessalonians 5:9: For God has not destined us for wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ,

2 TIMOTHY

• 2 Timothy 1:12: which is why I suffer as I do. But I am not ashamed, for I know whom I have believed, and I am convinced that he is able to guard until that Day what has been entrusted to me.

TITUS

• Titus 2:11: For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people.

HEBREWS

- ✓ Hebrews 7:25: Consequently, he is able to save to the uttermost those who draw near to God through him, since he always lives to make intercession for them.
- Hebrews 10:10: And by that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.

JAMES

• **James 4:6:** But he gives more grace. Therefore it says, "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."

1 PETER

• 1 Peter 1:3-5: Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, ⁴ to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you, ⁵ who by God's power are being guarded through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

1 JOHN

- 1 John 3:2: Beloved, now we are children of God.
- 1 John 4:17: By this is love perfected with us, so that we may have confidence for the day of judgment, because as he is so also are we in this world.
- 1 John 4:18: There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear. For fear has to do with punishment, and whoever fears has not been perfected in love.
- ✓ 1John 5:13: I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life.

✓ Acts 16:29-33: And the jailer called for lights and rushed in, and trembling with fear he fell down before Paul and Silas. ³⁰ Then he brought them out and said, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" ³¹ And they said, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household." ³² And they spoke the word of the Lord to him and to all who were in his house. ³³ And he took them the same hour of the night and washed their wounds; and he was baptized at once, he and all his family.
