SALVATION IS A FREE GIFT

- **Romans 3:24:** all are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus,
 - **Romans 8:32:** He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things?
 - **1 Corinthians 2:12:** Now we have received not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might understand the things freely given us by God.
 - **Revelation 21:6:** And he said to me, “It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning, and the end. To the thirsty I will give from the spring of the water of life without payment.
 - **Revelation 22:17:** The Spirit and the Bride say, “Come.” And let the one who hears say, “Come.” And let the one who is thirsty come; let the one who desires take the water of life without price.

JESUS PAID THE PRICE FOR OUR REDEMPTION

- **Matthew 20:28:** even as the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.”
- **1 Corinthians 7:23:** You were bought with a price; do not become bondservants of men.
- **1 Timothy 2:5-6:** For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, ⁶ who gave himself as a ransom for all, which is the testimony given at the proper time.
- **1 Corinthians 6:19-20:** do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, ²⁰ for you were bought with a price, so glorify God in your body.

JESUS BORE OUR SINS

- **Romans 5:8:** God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
- **1 Corinthians 15:3:** I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures,
- **Galatians 1:3-4:** Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ, ⁴ who gave himself for our sins to deliver us from the present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father,
- **1 Timothy 1:15:** The saying is trustworthy and deserving of full acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am the foremost.
- **Hebrews 1:3:** He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high,
- **Hebrews 9:28:** Christ, having been offered once to bear the sins of many, will appear a second time, not to deal with sin but to save those who are eagerly waiting for him.
- **1 Peter 2:24:** He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed.
- **1 John 1:7:** if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin.
- **1 John 2:2:** He is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world.
- **1 John 3:5:** You know that he appeared in order to take away sins, and in him there is no sin.
- **1 John 4:10:** In this is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.
- **Revelation 1:5:** from Jesus Christ the faithful witness, the firstborn of the dead, and the ruler of kings on earth. To him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood

ALL WE MUST DO IS REPENT BELIEVE AND RECEIVE

- **John 1:12:** to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God,
- **John 3:16:** God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.
- **John 6:29:** Jesus answered them, “This is the work of God, that you believe in him whom he has sent.”
- **Acts 10:43:** To him all the prophets bear witness that everyone who believes in him receives forgiveness of sins through his name.”
- **Acts 16:31:** Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household.
- **Acts 19:4:** Paul said, “John baptized with the baptism of repentance, telling the people to believe in the one who was to come after him, that is, Jesus.”
- **Romans 5:17:** if, because of one man’s trespass, death reigned through that one man, much more will those who receive the abundance of grace and the free gift of righteousness reign in life through the one man Jesus Christ.
- **Romans 10:9-10:** if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰ For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved.

- **Galatians 3:14:** so that in Christ Jesus the blessing of Abraham might come to the Gentiles, so that we might receive the promised Spirit through faith.
- **Hebrews 9:15:** he is the mediator of a new covenant, so that those who are called may receive the promised eternal inheritance, since a death has occurred that redeems them from the transgressions committed under the first covenant.
- **James 1:12:** Blessed is the man who remains steadfast under trial, for when he has stood the test he will receive the crown of life, which God has promised to those who love him.
- **1 Peter 5:4:** when the chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the unfading crown of glory.
- **1 John 3:23:** this is his commandment, that we believe in the name of his Son Jesus Christ and love one another, just as he has commanded us.
- **1 John 5:13:** I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life.

THERE IS NO OTHER PATH TO SALVATION

- **John 14:6:** Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

WILL YOU ACCEPT JESUS

- **Revelation 3:20:** Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and eat with him, and he with me.
- **Ephesians 3:16-17:** according to the riches of his glory he may grant you to be strengthened with power through his Spirit in your inner being,¹⁷ so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith—that you, being rooted and grounded in love,
