• The seventh angel blew his trumpet, and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, "The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Christ, and he shall reign forever and ever. (Rev. 11:15).

After the seventh angel sounded his seventh trumpet John sees another six angels.

- 1. **THE FIRST ANGEL: is seen** flying directly overhead with an eternal gospel to proclaim to those who dwell on earth, (Rev. 14:6).
- 2. **THE SECOND ANGEL:** followed, saying fallen, fallen is Babylon the great, she who made all nations drink the wine of the passion of her sexual immorality. (Rev. 14:8).
- 3. **THE THIRD ANGEL:** followed, saying if anyone worships the beast and its image and receives a mark on their forehead or their hand, they will also drink the wine of God's wrath. (Rev. 14:9-10).
- 4. **THE FOURTH ANGEL:** came out of the temple, saying put in your sickle, and reap, for the hour to reap has come, for the harvest of the earth is fully ripe. (Rev. 14:15).
- 5. **THE FIFTH ANGEL:** came out of the temple, who also had a sharp sickle. (Rev. 14:17).
- 6. **THE SIXTH ANGEL:** came out from the altar who had authority over the fire, and he told the one with the sharp sickle to gather the clusters from the vine of the earth, for its grapes are ripe. (Rev. 14:18).

The seventh, the first, the second and the third angel all proclaim a message, after which, the fourth, fifth and sixth angels begin to reap the harvest of the earth.

The first three angels:

- Are not to be understood as literal angels, because the Gospel is not given to angels to proclaim to mankind, rather these three angels signify, the vast multitudes of God's faithful ministers, teachers and followers of Christ who will boldly and zealously proclaim the Gospel during the latter days.
- The words, "having wings and flying swiftly," cannot be in heaven, for there is no need of the Gospel being proclaimed in heaven, rather it signifies the Gospel rapidity spreading throughout the world (perhaps made possible through global internet communication).
- Desiring to look-into the mysteries of the everlasting Gospel, signify those who have a zeal and passion to study the Gospel and share it with others.
- The angel with the everlasting Gospel signifies believers filled with the Spirit of God and desire as He does that the lost would be delivered from sin and death and saved to eternal life, and long to see God's Holy City Jerusalem exalted to be the praise of the whole earth.
