## THE SUN BECAME BLACK AS SACKCLOTH

• **Revelation 6:12:** When he opened the sixth seal, I looked, and behold, there was a great earthquake, and the sun became black as sackcloth, the full moon became like blood.

**Sackcloth:** was worn to signify sadness, grief, and morning. The sun becoming black as sackcloth can be taken literally or figuratively. Figuratively, "the sun become black as sackcloth, and the moon like blood, signifies the following:

- Fierce, violent, and bloodthirsty battles, and great bloodshed.
- Great and powerful kings, and their armies laying waste empires and nations, and bringing them to utter-ruin
- Extreme calamities and disasters of all kinds.
- The worlds governments and political powers, and its global banking system of finance, trade and commercialism collapsing.
- The removing of the principal gods of the heathens and the downfall of idolatry, for the sun was one of the chief deities they worshipped under various names.
- Those in the highest positions of power, authority, and influence (especially religious powers), being enormously corrupt, for the brightness of the sun is the brightest light above all other created lights, so becoming black denotes, all kinds of evil.

It should also be kept in mind that, though the fulfilment of the sun turning into darkness and the moon into blood, will not reach its fullest application until the final-end of this world as we know it and Christs return in glory, there may be many similar preliminary advents of oppression, war, natural disasters, catastrophes, earthquakes, famine, and judgments that occur through history until they reach their final and complete fulfilment.
