The One Immortal, Invisible Eternal True God.

The following verses shine a brilliant spotlight on the eternal truth that there is only one true God Jehovah and that there was no God before Him and there will be no other God beside Him or after Him. They highlight the truth that the one true God created all things and is the great God of heaven and earth and that we are all His Children. This is because God created Adam and we are all offspring of Adam and therefore all God's children.

- **Isaiah 43:10:** “You are my witnesses,” declares the LORD, “Before me no god was formed, nor shall there be any after me.”
- **Deuteronomy 4:35:** To you it was shown, that you might know that the LORD is God; there is no other besides him.
- **Deuteronomy 4:39:** the LORD is God in heaven above and on the earth beneath; there is no other.
- **Isaiah 44:24:** Thus says the LORD, your Redeemer, who formed you from the womb: “I am the LORD, who made all things, who alone stretched out the heavens, who spread out the earth by myself,
- **Isaiah 45:5-6:** I am the LORD, and there is no other, besides me there is no God; from the rising of the sun and from the west, that there is none besides me; I am the LORD, and there is no other.
- **Isaiah 45:18:** For thus says the LORD, who created the heavens (he is God!), who formed the earth and made it (he established it; he did not create it empty, he formed it to be inhabited!): “I am the LORD, and there is no other.
- **Isaiah 45:21:** Who told this long ago? Who declared it of old? Was it not I, the LORD? And there is no other god besides me, a righteous God and a Savior; there is none besides me.
- **Isaiah 45:22:** “Turn to me and be saved, all the ends of the earth! For I am God, and there is no other.
- **Isaiah 46:9:** for I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like me,
- **Psalms 83:18:** that they may know that you alone, whose name is the LORD, are the Most High over all the earth.
- **Psalms 86:10:** For you are great and do wondrous things; you alone are God.
- **Joel 2:27:** You shall know that I am in the midst of Israel, and that I am the LORD your God and there is none else.
- **Malachi 2:10:** Have we not all one Father? Has not one God created us?
- **Mark 12:29-32:** Jesus answered, “The most important is, ‘Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one -- NOW GO TO VERSE THIRTY-TWO --- ³² And the scribe said to him, “You are right, Teacher. You have truly said that he is one, and there is no other besides him.
- **John 17:3:** this is eternal life, that they know you the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent.
- **Romans 3:29:** Or is God the God of Jews only? Is he not the God of Gentiles also? Yes, of Gentiles also,

The words, “God is both the God of the Jews and the Gentiles highlights the truth that the one true God revealed in the Old Testament is the same God that Jesus (God's most beloved Son) revealed to all the world:

- By his life of compassion, mercy, grace and love.
- By the miraculous power that God poured out on him without limitation at his water baptism.
- By his resurrected immortal, eternal body when he appeared to his disciples after his death and resurrection.
- **1 Corinthians 8:4-6:** Therefore, as to the eating of food offered to idols, we know that “an idol has no real existence,” and that “there is no God but one.”⁵ For although there may be so-called gods in heaven or on earth—as indeed there are many “gods” and many “lords”—⁶ yet for us there is one God, the Father, from whom are all things and for whom we exist, and one Lord, Jesus Christ, through whom are all things and through whom we exist.

This verse shines a brilliant spotlight on the truth that there is only one true God and there is only one Lord Jesus Christ. The one true God is the immortal, invisible, eternal God Almighty the creator of all things and source of all life and the heavenly Father of the Lord Jesus Christ.

NOTE: the words, “One Lord Jesus Christ, by whom *are* all things, and we by him” (v6) have been mistakenly used to support the theory that Jesus is God the Creator, but notice the previous words Paul has just written, “There is only one God the Father, from whom are all things and for whom we exist.”

When Paul wrote a similar thing of Christ he was not referring to the original creation, but to the church, the body of Christ (i.e., it is through Christ we exist) and the “All things” refer to all things needed for eternal salvation (i.e., forgiveness of sins, God’s favour, mercy and grace, the promises to Abraham and eternal life) all things needed to be saved to eternal life and everlasting glory are in Christ. It is in this sense Paul made the statement, “Jesus Christ, through who are all things and through whom we exist.”

It means that without Christ there would be no Kingdom of God it simply would not exist. Christ was the central focus of Gods eternal mind and foreordained eternal plans and purposes for mankind’s eternal salvation long before the word was created and time began. Jesus never says he is God nor does he ever use the title God the Son, he only ever refers to himself as the Son of God or the Son of man sent from God His heavenly Father, adding to this there are literally multitudes of Scriptures that teach that the Father is the creator and the source of all things and that there is no other God beside Him.

SO CALLED GOD’S

The words, “For though there be many that are called gods,” does not mean that there are many god’s it refers to the gods that are created by the imagination in the mind by a strong belief in them. The human nervous system does not have a mind of its own and therefore automatically responds to whatever is painted on the imagination of the mind whether it is real or false.

The stronger the belief the greater effect the mental image on the imagination of the mind will have on the human nervous system. This is why deception is so deceptive. It matters not if the god people believe in is real or not the nervous system responds accordingly. If the god a person believes in is a wrathful, vengeful and judgmental god they will feel emotions of guilt and fear in contrast to this if the god a person believes in is a god of love and compassion, they we feel emotions of love and comfort. This is why faith should be based upon the Scriptures of the Bible and never upon on emotions. This does not mean emotions should be denied, God gave them to us to enjoy (especially in worship and praise) it just means that they should not be the foundation of our faith and what we believe.

It is through reading the Bible that we learn who the one and only immortal, invisible, eternal God is and His eternal will, plans and purposes for the world, the earth and for eternity.

FOOTNOTE

Since the belief that a person must believe Jesus is God to be saved to eternal life has taken such a stronghold in the Christian faith many who deny this teaching can feel intimidated (especially new converts) by those who believe Jesus is God and are often rejected by the traditional church as heretics and told that they cannot possibly be saved to eternal life. The following will bring comfort to every faithful believer who accepts the simple truth that God is the eternal, immortal, invisible Almighty creator and source of all life and that Jesus is His most beloved Son and hopefully shine a brilliant light upon how grossly wrong it is to believe that a man or woman believing in Christ is a heretic and cannot possibly be saved to eternal life simply because they do not hold to the traditional teaching that Jesus is God.

Especially since there is not one verse in the entire Bible that states:

- Sinners must believe that Jesus is God to be saved.

Nor is there one verse from Genesis to Revelations that says:

- Whoever believes that Jesus is God the Son will be saved.

In total contrast to this silence there are literally multitudes of Scriptures throughout the pages of the New Testament that very clearly proclaim: -

- Sinners must believe that Jesus is the Son of God to be saved.

And that say:

- Whoever believes that Jesus is the Son of God will be saved.

Surely if it was important to believe that Jesus was actually God to be saved to eternal life Jesus, the apostles and Paul would have told us at least once in all their teaching concerning salvation, but all we hear from Paul, the apostles and Jesus himself is them saying that we must believe that Jesus is the Son of God to be saved to eternal life.

Jesus said:

- This is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God *and* Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent (John 17:3).
