## A brief overview of the seven golden bowls of God's wrath.

Vials Seven Golden Bowls (Vials in KJV).

• Revelation 15:7: And one of the four living creatures gave to the seven angels seven golden bowls (vials in KJV) full of the wrath of God who lives forever and ever. (Rev. 15:7).

Golden bowls (vials in KJV) were shallow bowls normally used for incense, but in this verse, we read of seven golden bowls, being filled with the wrath of God.

The four living creatures may signify the following four things:

- 1. War.
- 2. Famine.
- 3. Disasters.
- 4. Death.

For it is through these four things that the wrath of God will come upon the rebellious nations. The allusion seems to be to a bowl or goblet filled with poison and giving it to enemies to drink, which was one of the common methods of destroying an enemy in ancient times. The four living creatures hand the seven vial/bowls filled with the wrath of God to an angel to pour out upon the nations in the latter days. The meaning is that God, in the latter days will commission seven angels to bring upon earth one plague/disaster after another, until all kings, rulers and governments are brought to ruin.

Asaph in one of his Psalms wrote:

• Pour out your anger on the nations that do not know you, and on the kingdoms that do not call upon your name! (Psalm 79:6).
